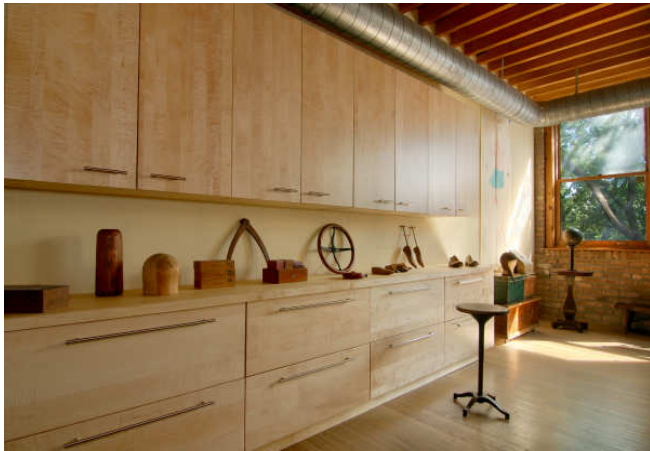

- 3/4" Formaldehyde-free Melamine infused particleboard is made from 40% recycled content and is available in white or almond color. **L RE**
- 3/4" Formaldehyde-free maple plywood offers greater durability. **L**
- 3/4" Formaldehyde-free maple plywood certified by the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) is assured to come from a sustainably harvested source. **L C**
